BECOME A VOLUNTEER

Our Volunteers provide the meaningful 'extras'. While our service funding meets the needs of our Residents, there is always more we want to do. It is our goal to move beyond managing risk and ensuring safety into promoting quality of life and enhancing living. To do this, we need helping hands by Volunteers doing things such as:

- Participating in (and/or chairing) the Family Council;
- Attending events and helping out as needed;
- Providing "porter" support (with proper training) to ensure everyone who can attend an event is able to get there;

- Helping with games, reading and light recreation services;
- Putting up decorations for festive events (such as a festival of lights); and
- Bringing your family and friends for meals and making the home a home.

There are many roles for Volunteers and we welcome the extra help. As we work with vulnerable people, our selection process requires detailed screening as well as proper training and orientation to ensure the best experience for all.
